

WELCOME TO THE HARRISON HILLS ATV TRAIL.

This trail is on land owned and managed by Lincoln County and is 50+ miles in length. It is developed and maintained by the Lincoln County Forestry Department for your use. The trail is open for your enjoyment except from December 1st through May 1st or when posted as being closed.

TRAIL ACCESS

There are six major parking areas for the Harrison Hills ATV Trail.

- 1) Turtle Lake Road – located .65 miles north of CTH J on Turtle Lake Road.
- 2) CTH B south – located 1.25 miles northwest of State Highway 17 on CTH B.
- 3) CTH B north – located .25 miles south of Parish Road on CTH B.
- 4) Harrison Convenience Store (food, fuel & parking) – located .50 miles east of the village of Harrison on CTH B.
- 5) Derek's Town & Country (food) – located at the intersection of State Hwy. 17 and CTH D.
- 6) Fishers Bar (food) – located on State Highway 17 in Parrish.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION

This trail is very scenic and traverses glacial moraines and upland hardwoods. It passes near cedar swamps, small creeks and lakes. Terrain is rolling to very hilly. This trail links up with the Langlade and Oneida County ATV trails.

TRAIL REGULATIONS

The Harrison Hills ATV Trail is a two-way trail located on old logging roads which are open to motor vehicle traffic, snowmobiles, hikers, mountain biking, horseback riding, skiers and many other recreationists. Please respect the rights of others and stop when you meet them on the trail. ATV use in wetlands and lake shorelines and cross country travel is not permitted. Gated or bermed woods' roads are not open to motorized use. ATVs with studded tires or chains are prohibited. Nonlicensed motorcycles are not allowed.



ROADS

ATVs are not recognized as licensed motor vehicles and, as such, shall not be operated on town or county roads or road right-of-ways unless signed for their use by the municipality having jurisdiction over these facilities. Therefore, ATV operators must check with local municipalities to identify roads that are open for ATV use.

ICE AGE HIKING TRAIL

ATVs are NOT allowed on the Ice Age Hiking Trail. The Ice Age Trail is identified by yellow paint.

LODGING

There are several private, state and county camping facilities available. Motels are also available in Merrill and Tomahawk.

TIMBER HARVESTING

The Lincoln County Forest is 100,000+ acres in size and is managed primarily for timber production, together with providing recreational, wildlife and other multiple use benefits. You may encounter some logging activity. Please use caution and respect the loggers' equipment as they earn their livelihood.

MISCELLANEOUS

Please respect the forest and other users. Don't litter or harass the wildlife. Your ATV registration fees have enabled Lincoln County to develop and maintain this trail. If you encounter a trail hazard, please report it to the Lincoln County Forestry Department in Merrill at (715) 536-0327. These maps are provided to you through the cooperative efforts of the Lincoln County Forestry, Land & Parks Department, the GIS division of the Lincoln County Land Information and Conservation Department, the Harrison Hills ATV Club, WDNR grant dollars from ATV registration fees and advertised sponsors.

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
